TORCH PRIVACY NOTICE

TORCH respects your privacy and we will only use your information in the way we describe in this notice. When using your information we aim to be fair and transparent, and to follow our obligations under UK data protection laws. Your information is used for administering club membership, activities and competitions. TORCH is the data controller for the purpose of GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. Our address is Swanmore College, New Road, Swanmore, Hampshire

Collecting your information

We collect your information when you fill in membership application or renewal forms, and competition event entry forms. You can give us your information using paper forms or online forms. The information you give us may include your contact details (name, address, telephone number, email address), personal information and identifiers (date of birth, membership number), and other information (transponder number for example). When you give us information about another person, such as a child, parent, guardian, or emergency contact you should let that person know that you have given us the information. If you are under 18 years old, we may also ask for information from your parent or guardian.

Using your information

We use your information when you first apply to become a member of TORCH and then to administer and renew your club membership, and provide you with member benefits. We also use your information when you enter club events. For competitions, we will publish some of your information in the heat listing and the results, which may be in the public domain. Your information is used in these ways to fulfil our contract with you.

We ask you for emergency contact and next of kin details which we will only use in an emergency, and which is use for a legitimate interest. You should let the contact and next of kin know that you have given this information to us.

We might use your information to send you marketing messages by email, but only if you have agreed that we can do this by giving us your clear consent – and you can change your mind at any time just by letting us know. We will not sell your information to another organisation.

To support your lifetime relationship with the sport and TORCH, we may keep your information indefinitely, unless you ask us to delete it.

Sharing your information

We may share you information with the British Radio Car Association as required by its General Rules for governing the sport, with medical personnel, or any other person if we have to comply with a legal obligation.

Our website

When you use our club website we may collect information about you, in particular your IP (Internet Protocol) address, by using cookies. We use this information to improve your web experience. Cookies help us to recognise you when you return to the website, and they may also help you to login securely to our web-based services, including on line entry.

The club website might contain links to other websites such as online entry and payment sites, partners, and advertisers. If you follow links to other websites please review the privacy policy for each site because we are not responsible for information you share on those sites.

Security for your information

Your information is held securely by us. We have taken all reasonable steps, and have in place appropriate security measures, to protect your information. Your information is not transferred outside the European Economic Area.

Your rights

TITCHFIELD OFF ROAD CLUB HANTS RULES

The classes we race are 1/10th scale electric off road 2WD & 4WD buggies. The rules for racing can be found on the BRCA website (http://www.brca.org/). For club racing we don't strictly enforce BRCA rules, but abide by them as best we can. As long as no purposeful cheating is apparent you will be able to race. This is a hobby and we are here to have fun! As a member of the club you agree to abide by these rules. Failure to do so may result in your membership being revoked.

- Foul, abusive or threatening behaviour anywhere within the site is not tolerated and you will be
 asked to leave immediately. When driving, if you crash, do not shout or use any threatening or
 abusive language or gestures to any Marshal.
- You are responsible for you litter. Please pick up your rubbish and leave the site clean and tidy.
- Anyone entering the track area must have a BRCA licence for insurance purposes.
- Track use is only permitted during organised meetings or practice sessions, unless authorised through the committee.
- Club transponders must be returned to race control at the end of the meeting. You must leave a form of security to be issued a transponder to ensure it is returned. (e.g. Car Keys)
- After your race, you must go to your designated marshal point. If you race, you must marshal.
 Failure to marshal will result in loss of your fastest time. Children under 10 years of age must be either accompanied or replaced by an adult BRCA member.
- Model car driving is potentially dangerous. Drivers must pay particular attention to the presence
 of marshals. When marshalling you must consider your safety, do not step onto the track
 without checking it is safe to do so first. Drivers must not be "on the throttle" when marshals are
 handling the car. As a marshal you do not have to retrieve a car that is being revved violently by
 a frustrated driver. Safety is paramount.
- All LIPO batteries must be charged in a LIPO pouch as per BRCA rule 25.6.
- During qualifying. If another car catches you up, they are obviously faster than you and you
 must move over to allow them pass. You are only racing against each other in the final. Any
 persistent bad driving, T-boning etc. may result in a penalty or disqualification.
